

Integrity policy Valu8

Which personal data is processed?

Personal data from persons involved in limited liability companies or other organisations through either key position, board, ownership or beneficial ownership. The sources of personal data are purely public documentation. No information about persons outside these categories is saved. Valu8 also processes personal data of customers.

What personal data is processed?

Personal data stored by Valuation Europe AB (Valu8) is name, birth date or birth year, including personal registration number in Sweden, board position, number of shares in given organisations, ownership or beneficial ownership in given organisations and address.

How is the collection of personal data performed?

The personal data is entered digitally into Valu8's databases via feeds or API solutions from group companies, subcontractors, government institutions and public authorities ('the suppliers'). The requirement for consent to collecting personal data falls on the suppliers of personal data to Valu8. In order to safeguard personal privacy, Valu8 takes responsibility to ensure that any potential comments or objections with regards to personal data or its collection of the data, reaches the suppliers so that adequate measures can be taken in accordance with the current legislation.

Why are these personal data stored?

Valu8's customers have commercial and legal interests in knowing which individuals are associated with companies they intend to interact with within the framework of their business operations. Valu8 does not determine or influence the purpose or scope of the data.

Who can access the personal data?

Valu8's customers access personal data through their access to Valu8's installed desk-top version or through the web version of the product. Access to the products and thus personal data is on an individual basis and requires an active subscription and a unique password unique to the individual user. Personal data is thus not part of an open registry but only available to registered Valu8 customers.

During how long time period is the personal data saved?

Due to the legal and commercial interest in the information, combined with its public nature, and the fact that the information, through public authorities, is widely available, the information is not obsolete and is constantly available. To protect personal integrity, Valu8 deletes documentation older than ten years, and performs annual checks of the database to delete obsolete data. Personal data of customers are deleted after seven years, as Valu8 has a legal obligation to keep records during this period, in accordance with Swedish accounting legislation.

Who is responsible for processing these personal data in accordance with current legislation? Personal data collection, compliance with current legislation and the protection of personal integrity fall under the responsibility of the Data Protection Officer.
